GOVERNMENT CUTS FORCE CLOSURE OF THE ARTISANS' GALLERIA

A non-profit gallery operated by The Community Arts Council of Richmond (CACR), has fallen victim to the Government cuts in funding to the arts and culture section.

Background information on the CACR is attached on their 40-year history of supporting the arts and artists in Richmond.

The Artisans' Galleria in historic Steveston Village showcases the work of their artist

members and is also the location for their many exhibitions and events held during the year which are free to the public to attend.

The economy, low tourism and financial restraints all play a role in this closing. However the cuts by the Provincial Government to funding the arts is by far the largest contributor. These cuts have had a domino effect on all other grantors. Increasing the number of non profit groups seeking grant funding and far exceeding the funds available.

The ability to receive funding for exhibitions and events offsets the expense of maintaining a venue, the only one of its kind in Richmond, where artists can exhibit and sell their work. Without funding for their exhibitions the CACR no longer has any extra funds to supplement the overhead costs of running the Gallery.

As a result they will close their doors by or before the end of summer. The CACR will continue to operate as a non-profit arts council, but it will be much more difficult and expensive to produce exhibitions at other locations. The artists will lose the income they receive from the sale of their work and the public loses a wonderful location to view works of art and exhibitions at no cost.

Re: "Onni seeks Steveston rezoning," News, August 27.

The Onni group of companies wants to create a lasting legacy on the waterfront in Steveston, on the site of the former BC Packers land.

Yes, the very same parcel of land involved in numerous public hearings, debates, and protests more than 12 years ago.

The same parcel of land for which it was concluded that the best possible deal was to have this industrial land rezoned to allow six buildings up to three (revised to four) stories with a total of 52 residential units atop 61,496 square feet of maritime mixed use business.

In return the residents of Richmond received the concession of a maritime zone, and a waterfront park, which in the later words of one city councillor amounted to "landscape for the development."

So what are we to receive now under the revised Onni proposal? An increase in density to 200 units, and an eliminated maritime zone in return for a widened strip of landscaping, or "waterfront park" in the shade shadow of 12- and 10-story high-rises, and a \$500,000 donation to a community centre whose proximity and amenities are a huge selling feature to the Onni complex.

The village of Steveston is ripe for development. What makes Onni so special that it is the only developer to be allowed to build a 12-story high-rise in the Steveston area?

Soon we will be faced with a plethora of developers crying "me too," and waving their community centre donation cheques and promising pocket landscaping, roof-top gardens, ground-level daycares and three social housing units in return for high density development.

The Steveston Village Conservation Strategy already calls for the owners of heritage designated buildings to be allowed to develop the rest of their land to a higher density as compensation for having to maintain the heritage.

Highest use development brings rapidly escalating property values and taxation which will soon result in preserved facades back ended with more 12-story towers. Again, Onni will set the precedent.

So you have to ask yourself, is this the lasting legacy for Steveston that you want? Where all that is left are a dozen historical facades surrounded by high density condominium development? Think it cannot happen, in a city where zoning bylaws, and planning seems to change with the tide?

Don't let developers continue to take end runs around existing zoning by promising park space that is really pathways and landscaping that first and foremost enhances the sales value of their development and will be predominantly used by the increased residential density.

Please say no to 10- and 12-story high-rises in the Steveston area and on the waterfront.

ANAF Unit # 284, Re-Opens in a Temporary Location

The Army, Navy & Air Force Veterans in



Canada are Canada's oldest veterans', exservice persons' and community service organization with more than 18,000 members throughout Canada. The first unit was formed in 1840 in

Montreal and our non-profit organization was incorporated by a special ACT of Canada's Parliament in 1917.

In 1946, thirty Steveston area vets approached the Army, Navy & Air Force Veterans in Canada for a Charter to open their own Veterans club in Steveston. Now here we are in 2010 – 64 years later – going strong and building a new clubhouse. Most Richmond residents and visitors have noticed the landmark ANAF Clubhouse on the corner of No. 1 Road and Chatham Street came tumbling down late last Fall. We then spent some time as the neighbourhood kitty litter pan, and now today the site sits bare with the pre-load removed and ready for the site servicing to begin shortly.

The obvious question is where will all these veterans', ex-service persons' and volunteers meet to continue their community support while the old site is under construction? If you stand on the site of the old clubhouse and look 'over yonder' you will spot the Coast Capital Credit Union. The second floor above the Credit Union is the temporary home for all the ANAF members to come together and continue their community support through various fundraisers, including their Thursday night free BINGO, their Friday and Saturday Meat Draws and the standby favorite – the LA Sunday Fundraiser.

The pool tables are set-up and the kitchen is

open each day for lunch, so stop up have a bite to eat and watch out the window as things start to take shape kitty-corner to the temp location.
